



CLUB APPAREL POLICY

INTRODUCTION

In order to maintain the Chilliwack FC brand and appearance, the Chilliwack FC Apparel policy sets a standard for clothing items that will be associated with Chilliwack FC. Coaches, assistant coaches, team managers, and Chilliwack FC executive member are obligated to ensure that players wear the approved apparel at all times when representing the Chilliwack FC.

If a team and or its players are found in breach of this policy, the player(s) in question, the coach, the assistant coach, and manager may be required to appear before the Chilliwack FC Board Executive and or the discipline committee of the Chilliwack FC. Disciplinary action may be taken.

The Chilliwack FC Executive will determine and approve the official team apparel and apparel brand on an annual basis.

THE POLICY

Club Names

The club names "Chilliwack FC", "CFC" and "Chilliwack Football Club" as well as the official logo of the Chilliwack FC are the property of the Chilliwack FC and may not be used or reproduced in any manner without the express written consent of the Chilliwack FC.

Club Colours

Official (Primary) Colours: Navy Blue, Red, and White are the official colours of Chilliwack FC. Wherever possible game jerseys will be comprised of one of these colours or a combination thereof.

Alternate Colours: Midnight Blue, Yellow, Gold, Black, Light Blue, Forest Green

The Chilliwack FC Executive may add additional alternate colours from time to time in order to meet the needs of specific programs requiring additional colours i.e. spring seven a side.

Official Team Apparel

The official team apparel supplied through player registration fees will consist of:

Fall Winter Development/Adult:

- U11-Adult One (1) pair of shorts;
- U11-Adult will receive two (2) game jerseys;
- U11-Adult One (1) pair of socks;

Fall Winter Recreational:

- U4-U18 One (1) pair of shorts;
- U4-U18 will receive one (1) game jerseys;
- U4-U18 One (1) pair of socks;

Spring Seven A Side:

- U4-Adult One (1) pair of socks;
- U4-Adult One (1) game jersey

Cascadia/Tournament Spring/Summer Teams:

- U8-Adult One (1) pair of shorts;
- U8-Adult One (1) game jersey;
- U8-Adult One (1) pair of socks

Skills Centre:

Note: At the time this policy was written, the Skills Centre Apparel is currently not included in the registration fee, however should that change apparel will include the following items:

- One (1) pair of shorts;
- One (1) game jersey;
- One (1) pair of socks

Camps (Day/Week):

- One (1) camp specific shirt/jersey.

When supplied as a part of the Official Team Apparel, the Chilliwack FC Executive will determine the colour of the goalkeeper jersey.

All under-garments worn with official team apparel must be one of the club's official (primary) colours.

Embellishments:

All Official Team Apparel will be embellished with the following: Chilliwack FC or Program logo, number (where applicable), sponsor logo (where applicable) and name bar. No other embellishments are permitted without consent of the Chilliwack FC Executive.

CLUB APPAREL POLICY

Special Event Apparel:

In the instance that Chilliwack FC participates in a special event that requires apparel specific to the event, the Chilliwack FC Executive will consider amendments to the above colour, apparel, and embellishment standards to meet the needs of the event.

Jersey Numbers:

Teams formed at U13 or are deemed new to Chilliwack FC, including blending of two (2) teams into one (1) will be bound to number selection below.

- Mini-ball: no numbers will be applied to these jerseys.
- U8 Prospects-U12: 2-16
- U13-Adult: 2-18, if a roster exceeds seventeen (17) players, numbers may be increased sequentially to the roster maximum.
- Goalkeeper: may choose their number

Addendum:

- a) For the 2021-22 Fall/Winter season, U8 Prospects-U12 and existing U14-Adult players may continue to use numbers assigned/chosen from the 2020-21 season.
- b) Should a player hold dual roles on a team (outfield player and goalkeeper) the player may choose to purchase a goalkeeper jersey and have their outfield player number put on the jersey for the purpose of consistency.

Team Apparel

Team Apparel is defined as items not included in a player's registration fee such as warm up suits (jacket and pant), training kits (jersey, short, sock), jackets (rain, track, winter). These items will be consistent with the Official (Primary) Colours of Chilliwack FC and its designated brand. Alternate colours may be considered with approval of the Chilliwack FC Executive.

Embellishments on team apparel will consist of: Chilliwack FC logo, player initials and or numbers. Sponsors and or other embellishments may be added to the team apparel with approval of the Chilliwack FC Executive.
